

CONCERN is a multi-service private non-profit 501(c)(3) human services organization dedicated to providing child welfare, juvenile justice, and behavioral health services to children and their families. Founded in 1978, CONCERN began as a pioneer of treatment foster care, believing that children placed into care should live in a traditional family setting in the community, rather than in a residential or institutional setting. Since this time, CONCERN has been at the forefront of innovative programs to meet the child's individual needs.

Areas of Service:

- Adoption & Permanency
- Foster Care is a temporary arrangement in which adults provide for the care of a child or children whose birth parent is unable to care for them. Adoption and Permanency are a more permanent arrangement.
- Behavioral Health Service offers professional, confidential, client-centered mental health treatment to individuals ranging in age from two to adulthood.
- **Community-Based Prevention Services** are social service programs that empower people in their own environment.
- Residential Treatment for Boys is a staff-secure, residential
 facility for adolescent males. The goal of this program is to
 change the mindsets and behavior patterns of the youth so that
 they will be able to function appropriately in society and will
 return to the community as healthy, productive citizens.
